<p>FOOD, DRINK & TABLEWARE</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure you are using local suppliers where possible • Incorporate more plant-based foods • No single-use tableware, glasses etc
<p>OTHER SUSTAINABLE OPTIONS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carbon offsetting • Cardboard/wooden name badges • Ensure using local suppliers
